The International Chorus Champion is Ambassadors of Harmony. The 133 men of the Ambassadors of Harmony captured their fourth gold medal singing "Something Good" from "The Sound Of Music" and The Carpenters hit "Top of the World." The chorus emerged at the top of a field of 29 choruses from the United States, Canada,

Sweden, New Zealand, and Australia. The choruses were in top 5 order: Ambassadors of Harmony, St. Charles, Missouri, Central Standard Kansas City, Missouri, Masters of Harmony, Santa Fe Springs, California, Toronto Northern Lights.
