The BucksMont Squires of Song will again bring a touch of barbershop to the Middletown Grange Fair on Thursday, August 13 beginning at 6:30 p.m.

The Squires, part of the Abington-Levittown chapter of the Barbershop Harmony Society, is made up of 24 men, ranging in age from 10 to over 90.

The group performs a wide range of show tunes, ballads and up-tunes, including songs like "Ain't Misbehavin'," "Over the Rainbow," "Ev'ry Day of My Life" and "In My Room."

During a typical year, the group entertains at numerous senior centers, civic organizations and social groups, putting on stage shows and caroling at hospitals and nursing homes.

Following their performance at 6:30 p.m., the members will stroll the fairgrounds performing in barbershop harmony.
