Mid-Atlantic District Results – The Fall Convention was held in Lancaster, PA. The Red Rose Chorus (Lancaster)(also the chapter of our dual member, Ed Eichner!) hosted the convention. Nineteen choruses competed. *Parkside Harmony* (Hershey, PA) is the <u>District Chorus Champion</u>. No. 2 was *Voices of Gotham* (Hell's Kitchen, NY), 3rd was *East Coast Sound* (Caldwell, NJ), 4th was *The Garden Statesman* (Princeton, NJ), 5th was *Baltimore Vocal Corps* (Dundalk, MD). Of interest, *Lansdale* captured No. 6, *Philadelphia* was 7th, *Cherry Hill* was 10th

and at 13th was *Bucks County*. Five hundred and fifty-five (555) men were onstage (19 chapters representing 1074 members) or, in raw numbers, 52% of the members were competing.

Twenty-two quartets competed. **Da Capo** (Washington, DC Area) is the <u>District Quartet Champion</u>.
