In the large audience, you could spot many of the people lip-synching with us – always a good sign they were enjoying the show.

79th Annual BHS International Convention

- The site for the Society's 79th International Convention was Las Vegas, Nevada. Planet Hollywood was the HQ Hotel. Thirty choruses and fifty-five quartets sang in the competition, plus twenty-three quartets in the Youth Barbershop contest. The Mid-Atlantic District (M-AD) was well represented in the final results.

The International Chorus Champion is <u>Masters of Harmony</u> (Santa Fe Springs, CA), scoring 96.4 percentile with 112 men on stage. The next four choruses were: 2nd - *The Vocal Majority* (Dallas Metro, TX), 96.2, 160 men; 3rd - *Central Standard* (Metro Kansas City, MO), 94.3, 56 men; 4th - *Toronto Northern Lights* (Toronto, ON), 94.0, 54 men; and, 5th - <u>Parkside Harmony</u> (Hershey, PA), 92.0, 49 men. The other M-AD Chorus, in addition to Parkside Harmony, was the 10th place <u>Voices of</u> <u>Gotham</u> (Hell's Kitchen, NY), 87.8 percentile, and 32 men on stage.

The International Quartet Champion is Main Street, scoring 92.8 percentile. The next four quartets were: 2nd - *Signature*, 92.5; 3rd – *After Hours*, 91.1; 4th – *Throwback*, 90.5; and, 5th – *Quorum*, 89.5. In 10th place, from M-AD, was '*Round Midnight*, 85.8 percentile. The Harmony Foundation International Youth Quartet Champion is Flightline, scoring 80.5. Two Youth Quartets from M-AD were: 5th place, *Brothers In Arms*, 77.5 and 10th place, *Tradition*, 75.2.
